Regrettably, not all work you may require your doctor to do is paid for by the NHS. Your doctor is entitled to charge a professional fee for the services listed below, as recommended by the British Medical Association. This list is not exhaustive. Some of the charges are likely to be reimbursed by your employer or insurance company. Please note this work will **not** take priority over NHS work, therefore please allow up to 28 days for the work to be completed.
